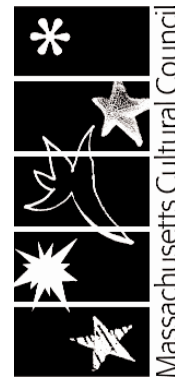
- 50% of your class fee is refundable after the first class.

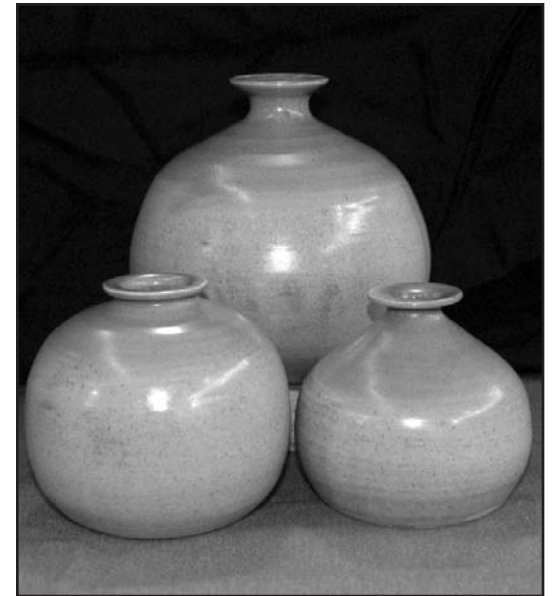
